## Visual Methods in Tourism Research: From Traditional Visuals to Big data

The novel visual landscape, characterised by big data availability, calls for a better understanding and usage of visuals in tourism research. Recent studies encourage new methodological perspectives and promote adequate visual analysis (Balomenou & Garrod, 2019; Volo & Irimias, 2020). This seminar will present different theoretical approaches and paradigms used in visual research and connecting them with participants research interests. Alternative methods of data collection and analysis of visuals will be discussed and suggestions on how to select, collect and analyze visual data will be provided. Participants will be encouraged to critically reflect on the opportunities and implications of using visual data and visual methods for their research projects.
